Need Help Paying Your Gas Bill?

If you're having difficulty paying your natural gas bill, the Gas Assistance Fund (GAF) may be able to provide you, or someone you know, with a one-time grant.

How To Qualify

To qualify for the Gas Assistance Fund, you must meet the following income requirements:

For each additional person in your household, add \$14,160.

These income guidelines are effective July 1, 2022 thru May 31, 2023.

Funds are available on a first come first served basis until funds run out. Grant awards and income guidelines are only applicable for the 2023 program year. The natural gas bill must be in the name of the applicant requesting assistance and the bill address must be the applicant's primary residence.
